There was a mistake in the September minutes. Elnora Corbin and Betty Mitchell were present at the meeting. They were omitted from the list of members present. With the corrections, the minutes were approved.

Treasure's Report- September balance on hand was \$2428.25. Deposits totaled \$1433.98, for a total balance of \$3862.23. Disbursements totaled \$165.03 to DKG leaving a balance on hand of \$3697.20. Linda Uballe submitted the treasurer's report.

Correspondence-Noemi Santana sent a letter to resign from Theta Gamma.

New Business

Shayla Floyd passed out ballots to vote for possible new members.

Angela Seagall presented information on her recommended initiates. They were Ann Falkner (her mother) taught math at King High School for 30 years, Gwynetta Hoelscher, a T-M High School English teacher, and Luanna Ortiz, a T-M Middle School technology application teacher.

All members present marked their ballots and turned them in.
