October 19, 2010

Business

Kimberly Brumley conducted the meeting due to the absence of the President and First Vice President.

Corrections were made to the September minutes as to the two Amendments to the Chapter Rules voted on and accepted at the September meeting. The correct reading of the amendments is as follows: Article XII, Section A, 2 now reads -

The grant is to be paid from fund raisers and/or the interest in the Esther Jane Roark Hahn Memorial Fund for a minimum of \$300 per scholarship to be used for tuition, fees, books or supplies. The Scholarship Committee must receive applications for the grant before the April meeting.

Article XII Section B, 2 now reads

The scholarship is to be paid from the interest in the May Blythe Scholarship Fund and/or fundraisers, not to exceed \$300 to be used for tuition, fees, books or supplies at a non-Society continuing professional education event.

Theo Wagner moved to accept the corrections to the minutes to reflect the amended by laws and Kathy Crow seconded the motion.

Linda Uballe presented the treasurer's report. As of October 19, 2010, Theta Gamma has a balance of \$1,188.19. She also gave the amount that was in the pig from September as \$13.00. The budget was presented by Beverly Tackett.
